2020\2021 COVID Protocols

- Temperature checks on all staff and children: No one with a temperature above 100.4 will be allowed to work or ride the bus
 - All Staff and Students will be required to wear a mask on the bus
- Family members will be sharing seats in a assigned seat assignment to prevent further spread of germs
- In quick turn around of routes the driver will be required to wipe down handrails
 before the next group boards
 - Total bus disinfecting will be required at the end of each am\pm\activity run
 - If a child is needing to be picked up at school for illness it will be the parents responsibility to do so

If a child or staff member becomes sick with COVID:

- Immediately report the situation to a Supervisor. Remember confidentiality
 must be maintained
 - The last bus the COVID patient came in contact with must be put out of service for 24 hours and then cleaned thoroughly before being put back into service.
 - Determine if any other students or staff may have been exposed to the symptomatic patient. (Within 6 feet for longer than 15 min. unmasked) If so, notify those individuals (or parents of) of the potential exposure Employees or Students who have developed COVID symptoms or have had a positive COVID test may not return to school\work until either of the following criteria have been met:
 - a. At least 10 days have passed since the first symptoms emerged.
 - b. At least 3 days have passed since recovery
 - i. Resolution of fever without fever-reducing medications
 - ii. Improvement of respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath)
 - c. The student or staff member has received negative results in an authorized COVID test.
